Informative Matters

Due to the success last year of the estate planning workshops hosted by the library with the Elder Law & Disability Rights Center, six more pairs of workshops have been scheduled for 2026. New this year: ELDR received a grant which will enable them to pre-draft documents for qualifying participants.

The library and other local agencies were contacted by attorneys for a person who was shot in the face with a “less lethal” munition during an incident outside the federal building on January 9. Per the firm’s request, and in consultation with library council, the library has placed a litigation hold on requested material and is reviewing for responsiveness.

FastCase was acquired by vLex last year. The library would have been required to transfer to vLex this year but declined as the new platform does not meet our needs.

Library staff continue to work with Eadie Payne LLP on a biennial audit for fiscal years 2024 and 2025.

Reminder: trustees and the director now must file our Form 700s directly with the state due to a recent change in the law. Those who had been filing only with the county should be receiving an email from the Fair Political Practices Commission about creating an account.

Pooled Money Investment Account Monthly Portfolio Composition ⁽¹⁾ 12/31/25 \$162.6 billion








Orange County Treasury Pool

Agenda VI

CWCAP Current Charges and Future Developments

A. Current Charges

The library contracts with the county for the provision of various services. Under the Memorandum of Understanding, the Auditor-Controller (A-C) provides annual written notification (attached) of the costs of accounting services for approval by the Law Library Board of Trustees. If approved, we pay the charge in one lump sum.¹ The amount is based on the current fiscal year Countywide Cost Allocation Plan (CWCAP), which uses actual cost data that is two years in arrears. Thus, the FY 2025-26 CWCAP charge of \$17,840 is based on FY 2023-24 actual expenditures.

The amount has fluctuated over the years based on changing usage and amortized charges for system upgrades:

The current charge is within \$1,478.00 of our budgeted estimate.

The A-C allocates costs to participating entities based on their relative usage of financial accounting systems (general accounting, claims, and disbursement) and human resources (payroll). The financial cost pool is allocated based on total financial transactions, while HR is based on direct hours paid. Also included are costs that can be traced specifically, such as postage. Countywide Accounting and Personnel System (CAPS) administration includes ongoing operations and maintenance costs.

“Intangible Use” includes the development and upgrade costs of various A-C systems which are amortized over their useful life.

B. Future Developments

The A-C and County Executive Office have commenced the implementation of a new Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) system. See attached memo. A-C provided the library with estimated cost projections prepared by the Cost, Revenue, and Budget unit. These projections encompass both Operations and Maintenance expenses for existing services and anticipated ERP implementation costs.

The estimates are derived from current actuals, historical trends, and contracted implementation costs, and they cover the period from FY 2024–25 through FY 2035–36. Staff will discuss the estimates at the meeting.

Action required: motion to approve payment of \$17,840 in CWCAP charges.

SUBJECT: County's Future ERP and Orange County Public Law Library Participation

As you are aware, the Auditor-Controller and County Executive Office have launched the implementation of the County's new Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) system. With direction from the Board of Supervisors (BOS), a thorough review was conducted on the County's ERP system, and it was clear that the current system (CAPS+) no longer meets all the County's needs. Based on this and BOS approval, the County issued a Request for Proposal (RFP) to adopt a modern software package. As a result of the RFP, Oracle Fusion Cloud was selected for the software solution and Deloitte Consulting LLP (Deloitte) was selected to be the implementation partner.

This multi-year project will result in replacement of the existing CAPS+ system and will be used for Finance, Budget, Procurement, Human Resources, and Payroll. Various other systems and process, such as timekeeping, asset management, and employee reimbursement, will also be part of this future ERP.

The project to implement the ERP officially started in April 2025. This multi-year project will be rolled out in phases spanning into 2028.

Key benefits include:

- **Centralized Platform:** Unifies Finance, Budget, Procurement, and HR.
- **Real-Time Visibility:** Provides up-to-date insights and analytics to support faster, data-driven decisions.
- **Improved Efficiency:** Streamlines and automates manual processes, reducing duplication and errors.
- **Enhanced Collaboration:** Fosters stronger connections across departments with shared data and standardized workflows.

Ultimately, Oracle Fusion Cloud will empower the County with better tools, improve collaboration across departments, and position the County for long-term agility and growth.

Existing MOU/Agreement language between Law Library and the County of Orange has the following language with regards to cost of services:

V. COMPENSATION FOR SERVICES

Where applicable, the County will provide the Law Library the estimated annual cost of providing the Services described in Attachments A through F. The County will provide this information to the Law Library on or before March 31 of each year for the next fiscal year. The rates charged to the Law Library for such Services provided shall be the same rates as those charged to County departments and special districts for the same or similar Services, and shall be subject to adjustment annually at the sole and exclusive discretion of the County. The Law Library agrees to compensate County at such rates in consideration for the Services provided by the County. Failure to provide the estimated annual cost to the Law Library shall not constitute a waiver by the County to increase its rates in the following fiscal year; provided that, and despite anything to the contrary, (1) no such increase shall be effective until and unless the Law Library receives written notice of such increase at least one hundred twenty (120) days before the effective date of the increase, and (2), within thirty (30) days after receipt of such notice of increase in rates, the Law Library may terminate this MOU upon ninety (90) days written notice to County.

Attached to this communication are estimated projections that were calculated by our Cost, Revenue, and Budget (CRB) unit that include both Operations and Maintenance (O&M) costs for existing services as well as ERP Project implementation costs projections. Both cost areas are estimates utilizing existing actuals, trends, and current contracted implementation costs. These estimates are covering the period from FY 2024-25 through FY 2035-36. The Excel file contains multiple tabs with details that populate the three main tabs to focus on which are:

- Assumptions
- A MOU Projections (Existing Services Currently Billed)
- C-1 ERP (New Amortization Costs for Implementation)

Additionally, the new ERP will establish each special district as a “legal entity” under the County of Orange. The resulting legal entity will be a Tax Reporting Unit (TRU). Further, the County of Orange will hold a Payroll Statutory Unit (PSU) status. To fully leverage the new ERP system and its functionality, every special district will be required to provide the Auditor-Controller’s Office with a W9 reflecting its Tax ID and bank account information. Specific requests for these two items, along with additional details on this functionality and setup, will come later as the project gets to a point in the implementation where it needs specific details.

Please review the file and let me know if you have any questions or if you would like to meet to discuss in person. The A-C Project Management Office (PMO) will continue with implementation efforts that incorporate your special district in the future ERP unless the County hears otherwise from your district on a different direction.


