Informative Matters

Staff are happy to report that there were no visible leaks on Floor A after the last rains.

The Council of California County Law Librarians (CCCLL) met remotely on November 1. Of potential interest to the board, a mutual aid committee is researching methods for the more financially stable county law libraries to support those libraries that are struggling, even with supplemental funding from the state.

The director was elected vice president of CCCLL for a two-year term.

The director attended a webinar on criminal justice reform efforts featuring Georgetown Law Professor and former federal inmate Shon Hopwood. Reference librarians attended sessions on online search strategies, data available from U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services, and researching federal education statistics.

As predicted at the October meeting, where the board approved prepayment of the library's FY2022-23 retirement contribution to OCERS, a credit of \$5,520.12 for overpayment in a prior year has been applied. This brings the current prepayment amount down from \$119,973.79 to \$114,453.67.

Staff continue to monitor public health information closely. To date, there have been no COVID-19 infections among library staff.

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Minutes of Meeting

Board of Trustees
Orange County Public Law Library

The Board of Trustees of the Orange County Public Law Library met on October 19, 2021 at 12:15 p.m. via video- and tele-conference pursuant to Government Code § 54953(e).

Present: Mr. Michael D. Franco, Esq., Hon. Jacki C. Brown, Hon. Julian Bailey, Hon. William Claster, Hon. Elizabeth G. Macias, Hon. Glenn Salter, and Brendan Starkey.

Absent: Prof. Sherry L. Leysen.

President Franco called the meeting to order at 12:17 p.m.

- Agenda I Discuss Informative Matters. The director discussed developments at the library since the last board meeting.
- Agenda II Consider FY2019-20 and FY2020-21 Audit. After a presentation from Eden Casareno of Eadie & Payne, LLP, Judge Brown moved to receive and file the biennial audit report. Judge Claster seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.
Approved 6-0
- Agenda III Minutes of September 21, 2021 Meeting. Judge Claster moved that the minutes be approved. Judge Bailey seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.
Approved 6-0
- Agenda IV Minutes of October 7, 2021 Special Meeting. Judge Brown moved that the minutes be approved. Judge Salter seconded the motion, which passed. Judge Claster and Judge Macias abstained.
Approved 4-0
- Agenda V Consent Calendar. There being no objection, summary investment reports from the Local Agency Investment Fund and the Orange County Investment Pool for September were deemed received and filed.
Approved 6-0
- Agenda VI Consider FY2022-23 Retirement Rates. The board of the Orange County Employees Retirement System (OCERS) set the library's employer contribution rates for FY2022-23 at 13.88% for legacy employees and 10.51% for employees

hired after the California Public Employees' Pension Reform Act. Judge Claster moved to adopt and approve implementation of those rates. Judge Brown seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Agenda VII Consider Prepayment of FY2022-23 Retirement Contribution. The director reviewed the offer by OCERS of a discount rate of 5.8% used in calculating the present value of discounted cash flows if the library pays the entire employer contribution for FY2022-23 by January 15, 2020 and 2.9% if paid by July 15. Judge Claster moved to prepay by January 15 to obtain the 5.8% discount. Judge Salter seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Agenda VIII Consider Whether to Use Teleconferencing for November 16 Regular Meeting. The board revisited its determination at the October 7 special meeting that, as a result of the ongoing public health emergency, meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health and safety of attendees. It found that (1) the state of emergency continues to exist and (2) directly impacts the ability of attendees to meet safely in person. Judge Baily moved, in light of these findings and pursuant to Government Code § 54953(e), that the November 16 meeting be held by teleconference. Judge Salter seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Agenda IX Comments from Trustees and Staff. The board discussed Superior Court Erick Larsh's inquiry about potential nominations to fill the vacancy on the board left by Judge Brown's retirement.

Agenda X Public Comment per Government Code § 54954.3. There was no public comment.

Agenda XI Farewell and Thanks to Hon. Jacki C. Brown. The board and staff thanked Judge Brown for her seven years of service to the library. The director informed her that a set of engraved bookends were ordered in commemoration.

Pooled Money Investment Account Monthly Portfolio Composition ⁽¹⁾ 09/30/21 \$179.1 billion

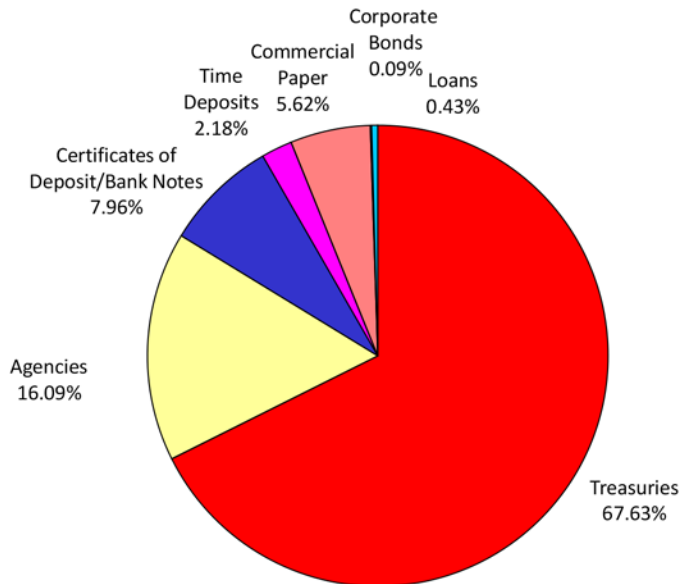

Agenda IV

Set December Meeting Date and Consider Whether to Use Teleconferencing

Date and Time

The date and time of the December joint meeting of the board and staff have not been set. Based on earlier feedback, December 1, 2, 3, 9, or 10 at 12:15 are good options.

Teleconferencing

The Ralph M. Brown Act governing meetings of the legislative bodies of local government agencies allows the use of teleconferencing at meetings if (1) each teleconference location is identified in a public notice of meeting and accompanying agenda and agendas are posted at each location; (2) each teleconference location is publicly accessible and available for public comment; and (3) a quorum of the members of the legislative body participate from locations physically within the jurisdictional boundaries of the agency. Gov. Code § 54953(b)(3).

A recent amendment to the act relaxes these requirements if the legislative body holds a meeting during a proclaimed state of emergency and

- (1) State or local officials have imposed or recommended measures to promote social distancing;
- (2) The meeting is held for the purpose of determining, by majority vote, whether as a result of the emergency, meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health or safety of attendees; or
- (3) The legislative body has determined, by majority vote, pursuant to [exception (2) above], that, as a result of the emergency, meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health or safety of attendees.

Section 54953(e)(1) (as amended Sept. 16, 2021 by A.B. 361).

The legislative body must then revisit that determination within 30 days and make the following findings by majority vote if it wishes to hold its next meeting by teleconference:

- (1) The board has reconsidered the circumstances of the state of emergency, and
- (2) Any of the following circumstances exist:
 - (a) The state of emergency continues to directly impact the ability of the members to meet safely in person; or
 - (b) State or local officials continue to impose or recommend measures to

promote social distancing.

See § 54953(e)(3).

This meeting is being held by teleconference after the board made the requisite determination by majority vote at its October regular meeting. It must now revisit that determination for the purposes of the December meeting.

Actions required: findings that (1) the state of emergency continues to exist and (2) directly impacts the ability of attendees to meet safely in person, and a motion to accept or reject the findings and to set the location of the December meeting.

Annual Review of Investment Policy

By board policy, an annual review of the library's investment policy is set for a fall meeting each year. A copy is attached.

ORANGE COUNTY PUBLIC LAW LIBRARY INVESTMENT POLICY

Statement of Intent

The Board of Trustees of the Orange County Public Law Library hereby adopts the following investment policy for all funds received by the Law Library. The Investment Policy is intended to fulfill the requirements of Bus. & Prof. Code Sec. 6320 (Disposition of Moneys); Bus. & Prof. Code Sec. 6348.5 (investment of Surplus Funds); Gov. Code Sec. 53646 (Investment Policy Statement; Review and Approval; Legislative Body or Oversight Committee; Reports); and Gov. Code Sec. 53684 (Local Agencies; Excess Funds; Investment by County Treasurer).

It is the intent of the Board of Trustees to fulfill the prudent investor standard when considering the deposit/investment of all money received by the Orange County Public Law Library.

Deposit of Money Received All money received from any source by the Orange County Public Law Library ("Law Library") shall be deposited with the Treasurer of the County of Orange.

Determination of Surplus Funds

The Law Library Director shall determine if the Law Library has funds in excess of \$100,000.00. If the Law Library Director determines that funds exist in excess of that amount, then those funds shall be defined to be "Surplus Funds" under Bus. & Prof. Code Sec. 6348.5.

Disposition of Surplus Funds

Any amount of the Surplus funds as determined by the Board of Trustees may be deposited and/or invested in the following types of accounts:

1. Treasurer of the County of Orange [Gov. Code Sec. 53684]
2. Local Agency Investment Fund [Gov. Code Sec. 16429.1]
3. Financial institution which is insured by the FDIC (Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation) to a maximum of the insurance, \$250,000.00 [Gov. Code Sec. 53646(e)]

Report to Board of Trustees

Once every thirty (30) days, the Law Library Director shall report the investments of the Surplus Funds in the regular agenda to the Board of Trustees. The reports may be of the statements received from the deposits/investments referred to above without further amplification unless requested by the Board of Trustees. [Gov. Code Sec. 53646(e)]

Agenda VI

Annual Review of LAIF Account

In 2001, the board resolved to conduct an annual review of the library's account in the state's Local Agency Investment Fund (LAIF). In 2000, the board set a limit of \$20,000,000 for this account. The State Treasurer's limit on any LAIF account is \$30,000,000.

As of October 31, our balance is \$5,269,491.45. Interest earnings were trending upward but have dropped substantially due to the COVID-19 pandemic:

Earnings this fiscal year are projected to be even lower. With two of four payments received, our interest balance for the year thus far is \$7,503.

LAIF and the county commingled pool are the library's only major investment options. LAIF's latest interest rate of 0.24% is lower than the county's 0.46%.

Action required: motion to maintain LAIF account.

Staff recommendation: approve.

Agenda VII

Consider Special Holiday Hours

The number of patrons using the library during the last two weeks of December drops substantially every year. Staff request approval of special holiday hours of 8 a.m.-5 p.m. for December 20-22 and 27-29, closing one hour earlier than the usual 6 p.m. This will allow a single shift of staff to cover operations on those days. The library will be closed altogether on December 23-24 and December 30-31:

Consider Major Acquisitions

In light of the state's most recent grant of supplemental funding to the library, staff present this first proposal of potential upgrades to the library's materials and services.

ABA Digital Library Package

\$7,500/yr.

This add-on to the LexisNexis Digital Library includes 784 titles covering, e.g., litigation, intellectual property, government law, law practice management, professional development, and more. The library receives most of this material in print, but adding it to the Digital Library will (1) make it available remotely to patrons with a library account and (2) ensure all titles are available even when our physical copies are checked out.

Westlaw Enhancements

\$900/mo.

This would add West's Practical Law and Edge Search products to our current Westlaw offerings. Practical Law is a library of secondary legal content developed by West attorney-editors, including annotated document templates, explanatory articles, and checklists that are cross-linked to other Westlaw content. Practical Law materials consistently are the top "warning screen events" for our Westlaw users, i.e., users receive an "out of plan" message when attempting to access the material from within other Westlaw documents.

Edge Search is a set of enhancements to Westlaw's search feature that adds more sophisticated predictive language to the standard Westlaw search bar, summaries to search results, and enhanced document synopsis features, among other things.

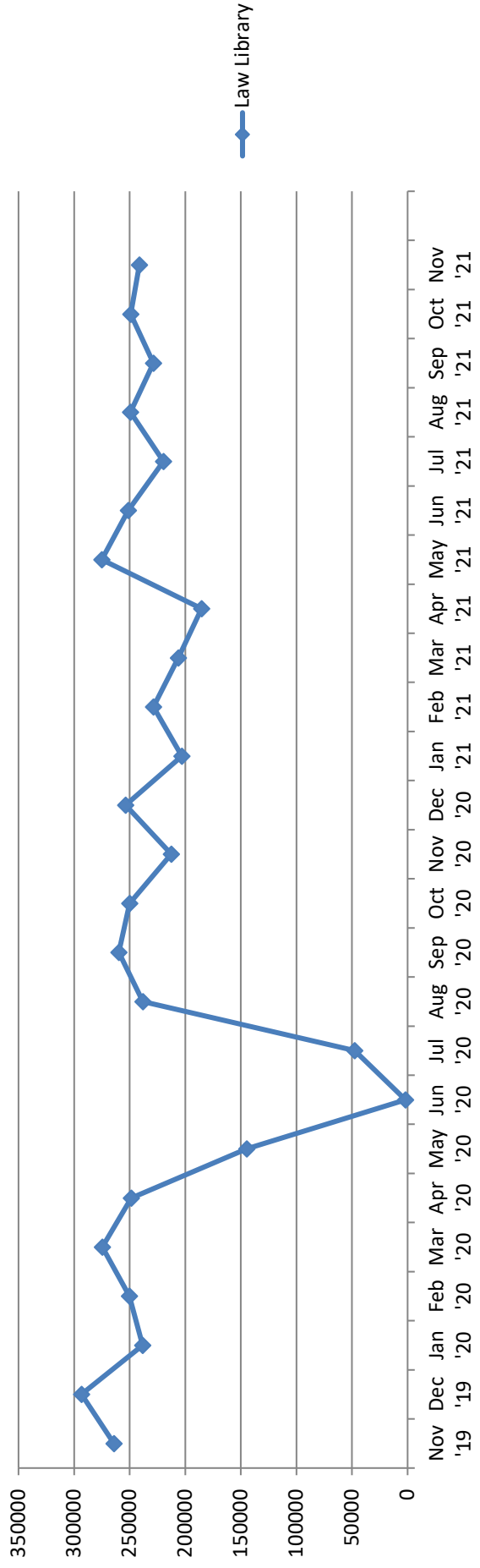
