Pooled Money Investment Account Monthly Portfolio Composition (1) 09/30/23 \$156.4 billion



Consider Prepayment of FY2024-25 Retirement Contribution

The board of the Orange County Employees Retirement System (OCERS) has approved discount rates for employers who prepay their expected FY2024-25 contributions. The rates are 7.0% discounted cash flow if prepaid by January 11, 2024 and 3.5% discounted cash flow if paid by July 11. See attached letter. These discounts are higher than they have been for some time:

FY	Discount

2023-24	5.80%
2022-23	5.80%
2021-22	5.80%

The library has taken advantage of these prepayment offers for over 15 years.

Most Library employees were hired before the California Public Employees' Pension Reform Act (PEPRA) of 2013. The "legacy" (Plans G & H) employer rate for those employees next fiscal year is 13.49%. The employer rate for employees hired after PEPRA is 10.48%. (One employee does not participate in OCERS.) All participating employees pay 1.75% in reverse pick-up, so the net employer rates for FY2023-24 are 11.74% and 8.73%.

The staff projection for FY2024-25 employee salaries is \$1,227,925 (not including the non-participating employee). After the discounts are applied (see attached chart), the payment would be \$126,471 by January 11 or \$130,747 by July 11.

Action required: motion to prepay employer retirement contribution for FY2024-25.

Staff recommendation: approve.

Re: Early Payment of Employer Contributions Program

Dear Mr. Starkey,

On July 17, 2023, the Board of Retirement approved an early payment of employer contributions program for the contribution year July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025 as follows:

- Payment must be received by January 11, 2024 to have a discount rate of 7.0% used in calculating the present value of discounted cash flows.
- Payments received after January 11, 2024 but before July 11, 2024 will have a discount rate of 3.5% used in calculating the present value of discounted cash flows.
- At least 50% of projected employer contributions, net of prepaid discount, for the year must be paid.
- Contributions not paid early must be paid pro rata over the year with no discount being credited.
- OCERS' staff will compare the payroll estimates used to calculate the
 prepayment amount for each participating employer to actual payroll each
 pay period. Should actual payroll be 5% greater than estimated payroll for
 four consecutive pay periods, the employer will be required to pay
 additional contributions each pay period for the additional salary above the
 projected salary used to calculate the prepayment (no discount would be
 applied to the additional amount)
- Employers that have more than one plan or rate group are required to provide the estimated pensionable salary separately for each plan or group.

- Only employer contributions paid by the employer are eligible for the prepaid discount program (employee pick-ups and reverse pick-ups are ineligible).
- The application of the prepayment of contributions will be applied to pay periods 2024-15 through 2025-14.
- OCERS will reconcile the prepaid contributions to the actual contributions at the end
 of the contribution year. Any overpayments will be made available to either apply to
 the following year's prepayment of employer contributions or to the current year's biweekly employer contributions (Note: overpayments cannot be applied to employee
 contributions). Any underpayments will be collected from the employer.


