Agenda I

Informative Matters

Trustees should have received an email from the Clerk of the Orange County Board of Supervisors about filing a Statement of Economic Interests, California Fair Political Practices Commission Form 700. If any trustees elect not to e-file, library staff can prepare a Form 700 cover sheet and handle the filing once the trustee has signed and provided any required schedules. The judges must file two forms, one as a judge and one as a trustee. We can use copies of schedules attached to the judicial filing, but the trustee filing must have an original signature on the cover page. It must be filed by April 1, 2021, a month later than the judicial filing.

Cal/OSHA's COVID-19 Non-Emergency Regulations ended February 3. In response, and following the county's lead, the library ended its COVID-19 Special Operating Procedures and COVID-19 Prevention Plan. Staff are no longer required to report COVID-19 cases. Notifications, exposure tracking, employer-provided testing, and use of face coverings also are no longer required. Staff are encouraged to stay home when ill. In the event a public health emergency is declared due to an aerosol transmissible disease (ATD), the library's response will be governed by its ATD Program, a permanent addition to its Emergency Action Plan.



The library continues to host a weekly consumer debt workshop provided by Community Legal Aid SoCal and Public Law Center. Attendance has steadily increased since the program began and the providers expect even more attendees at the library as they consolidate locations.

Cataloging Assistant Patrice Vizzerra earned a Masters in Library and Information Science from San Jose State University. Congratulations to Patrice!

Library staff completed training on serving a diverse population. The class, *Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) in the Library: Expectations and Awareness*, was well-received.

Staff also completed mandatory biennial sexual harassment prevention training offered by the California Civil Rights Department (CRD). Staff will be updating the library's current harassment prevention plan to incorporate changes recommended by CRD. A draft will be presented for the board's review.

The library instituted a state-mandated workplace violence prevention plan in consultation with the county. Staff have received training on the plan and will be collaborating this month to tailor the policy more specifically to the library's needs and circumstances. This also will be presented for the board's review.

Library staff have completed an exhaustive project to remove dead records from our integrated library system. Staff continue to work on consolidating and improving existing records.

Staff are preparing proposals to improve the library's closed-circuit television, phone, and network systems.

The director attended the 53rd Institute of the Southern California Association of Law Libraries in San Diego February 7-8. The program focused on applications of AI in the legal field. Of particular interest were improvements made to AI legal research applications by the top legal information vendors, which are performing much better than they were a year ago. This seems to be driven in part by the development of customized ontologies by vendors and related organizations.

The Elder Law and Special Needs Section of the Orange County Bar Association will be meeting at the library Monday, April 7.

The Superior Court now is providing equipment and support at the Central Justice Center for those needing to attend court hearings online.

The Council of California County Law Librarians' (CCCLL) long-time lobbyist Michael Corbett passed away unexpectedly in October. The director has been working with a hiring committee of CCCLL members to interview candidates.

The director attended the 2025 Local Agency Investment Fund Webinar on February 13 regarding the current status of and expected returns on the fund.

B. Professional Development Funds Adjustment

The board allots a professional development allowance to each of the five professional librarians each year that funding allows. The allowance currently is \$3,000. Expenses for the director's attendance at the annual meeting of the American Association of Law Libraries in Chicago last summer (registration, transportation, and hotel) were all drawn from this fiscal year, leaving a balance of \$133.56. (AALL expenses typically fall over two fiscal years due to the timing of the conference.) The director asks for an increase of \$319.86 to his professional development allowance to cover registration and hotel for the 53rd Institute of the Southern California Association of Law Libraries in San Diego.¹

Attached are summary investment reports from the Local Agency Investment Fund and the Orange County Investment Pool for November, December, and January.

¹ The other professional librarians have not drawn on their allowances this year. The board also budgets for the director to attend two meetings annually of the Council of California County Law Librarians. No expenses were incurred for the fall meeting, which was online. Thus total travel expenditures this fiscal year will be lower than usual.

Pooled Money Investment Account Monthly Portfolio Composition ⁽¹⁾ 12/31/24 \$155.4 billion

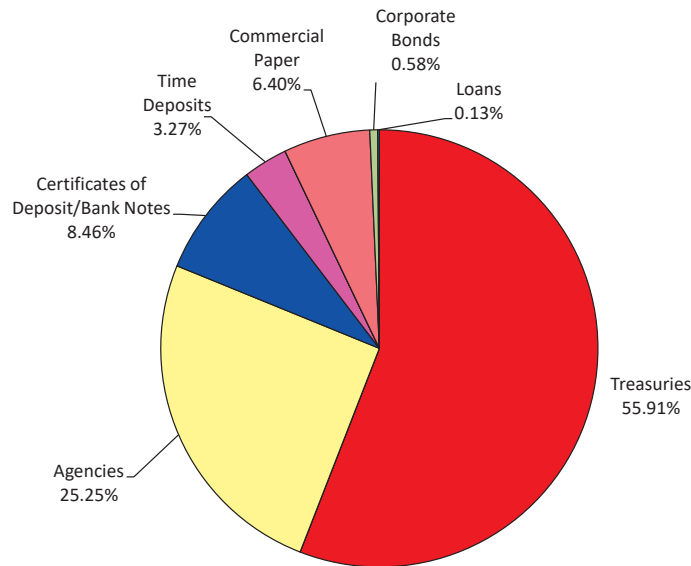

Agenda V

Consider FY 2024-25 CWCAP Charges

The library contracts with the county for the provision of various services. Under the Memorandum of Understanding, the Auditor-Controller (A-C) provides annual written notification (attached) of the costs of accounting services for approval by the Law Library Board of Trustees. If approved, we pay the charge in one lump sum.¹ The amount is based on the current fiscal year Countywide Cost Allocation Plan (CWCAP), which uses actual cost data that is two years in arrears. Thus, the FY 2024-25 CWCAP charge of \$15,846 is based on FY 2022-23 actual expenditures.

The amount has fluctuated over the years based on changing usage and amortized charges for system upgrades:

The current charge is within \$696 of our budgeted estimate.

¹ Other county departments charge us on a monthly or as-needed basis.

The A-C allocates costs to participating entities based on their relative usage of financial accounting systems (general accounting, claims, and disbursement) and human resources (payroll). The financial cost pool is allocated based on total financial transactions, while HR is based on direct hours paid. Also included are costs that can be traced specifically, such as postage. Countywide Accounting and Personnel System (CAPS) administration includes ongoing operations and maintenance costs.

“Intangible Use” includes the development and upgrade costs of various A-C systems which are amortized over their useful life.

Action required: motion to approve payment of \$15,846 in CWCAP charges.

Council of California County Law Librarians Mutual Aid Program Update

California's 50+ county law libraries (CLLs) are funded primarily by a portion of civil case filing fees. Beginning about a decade ago, changes to that system caused revenue to plummet. CLLs including the Orange County Public Law Library (OCPLL) had to reduce collections, services, and staffing and defer maintenance and equipment purchases. The Council of California County Law Librarians (CCCLL), an association representing the CLLs, lobbied the legislature and governor for additional funding to cover the deficits.

In 2018, the state came through. OCPLL's portion of that supplemental funding was \$1,515,086. The state again provided supplemental funding in 2020 to cover pandemic-related losses and then again in 2021 and 2022. OCPLL's portions were \$939,313.83, \$1,277,834.99, and \$1,446,635.53, respectively.

The formula for allocating the supplemental funding was based on the percentage of civil case filing fees statewide that each county receives, which led to the larger law libraries receiving more while the smaller received less. As a result, the smaller libraries continue to struggle financially. Many operate with significantly reduced hours, insufficient collections, and limited staffing. Some struggle to stay open at all or provide even minimal legal information services to their patrons.

As the purpose of the state supplemental funding was to improve access to legal information services statewide, CCCLL constituted a Mutual Aid Committee to help address the disparity. The committee created a grant process by which functioning CLLs could share some of their state funding with struggling CLLs to assure that certain minimal standards are met in every participating county in the state.

This board found that:

- 1) A grant of funding to struggling CLLs by OCPLL serves the public purpose of ensuring access to legal information services by the public throughout California by assuring that certain minimal standards are met in every participating county.
- 2) A grant of funding to struggling CLLs would benefit OCPLL directly. When Californians cannot find the services they need in their own county, they often look to other counties to fill in those gaps. The burden then falls on CLLs elsewhere in the state to provide that service. OCPLL provides telephone, email, and live chat service to patrons outside of Orange County on a daily basis. Staff also send needed materials, electronically and physically, at OCPLL's expense, to colleagues at other CLLs who have smaller and less current collections. OCPLL's load would be reduced by other counties having more robust services and collections.

- 3) While serving the residents of Orange County remains OCPLL's priority, the board shares state legislators' concern in supporting access to justice throughout California, as evidenced by OCPLL's provision of services to patrons statewide.

In light of these findings, the board contributed 7% of the supplemental funding provided by the state legislature to OCPLL in FY2021-22, or \$89,448, to CCCLL's mutual aid grant fund.

Three other counties contributed as well, for a total of \$197,948.00.

Three grant cycles of taken place since. The Mutual Aid Committee, composed of CLL directors from across the state, review applications and make recommendations to the CCCLL board, which has the final approval. Grant recipients submit mid-year and final reports to the committee to ensure that grant funds are being used as intended.

A total of \$164,282 has been awarded, leaving a balance of \$33,666.

Awardees include Butte, Lake, Mendocino, Nevada, San Mateo, and Santa Cruz counties, with some receiving multiple grants. Some applications have been denied due to insufficient showing of need.

Grants have gone toward purchasing access to online resources such as the Lexis Digital Library, LexisNexis, CEB OnLAW, Westlaw, and the EBSCO Legal Information Reference Center, and print materials such as current codes, CEB titles, Nolo Press titles for self-represented litigants, Spanish language materials, and titles in high-demand subject areas such as landlord-tenant. In all cases, the receiving libraries had either canceled or were facing cancelation of the resources for which they received grants.

A fourth grant cycle will commence shortly.

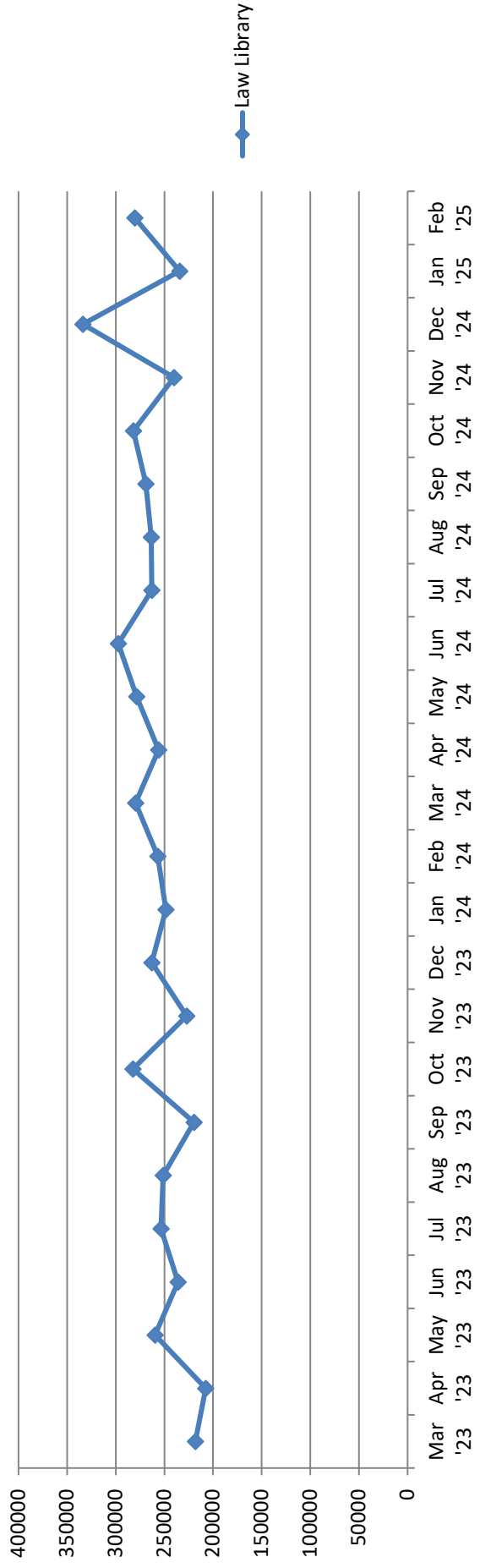
