Agenda II Update on Law Library Building. The director discussed the county's request at

an August 1 meeting with the Ad Hoc Building Committee that the library vacate its building by June 2024 so that it could be turned over to the Superior Court. The board determined it needed more information and asked the

director to make inquiries with appropriate county personnel.
